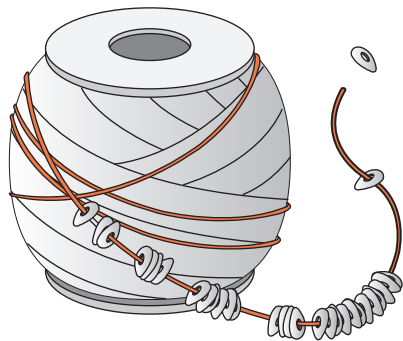
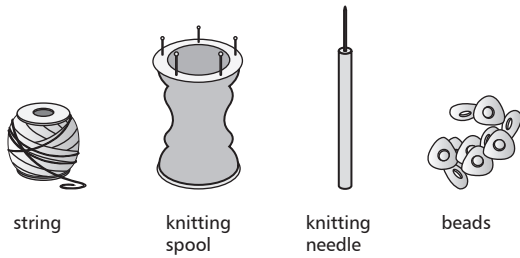


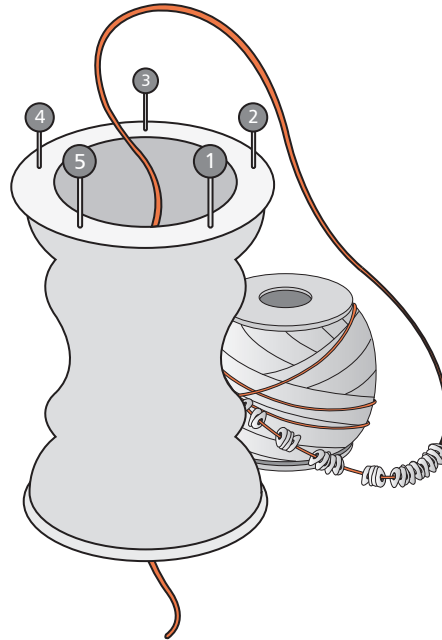
# spool knitting - phase 1

## getting started

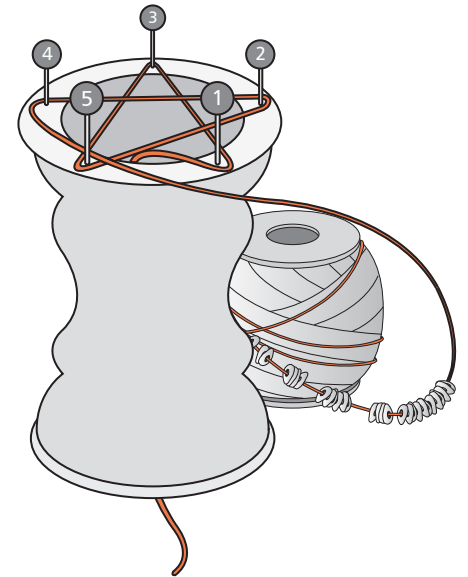
you will need the following supplies:



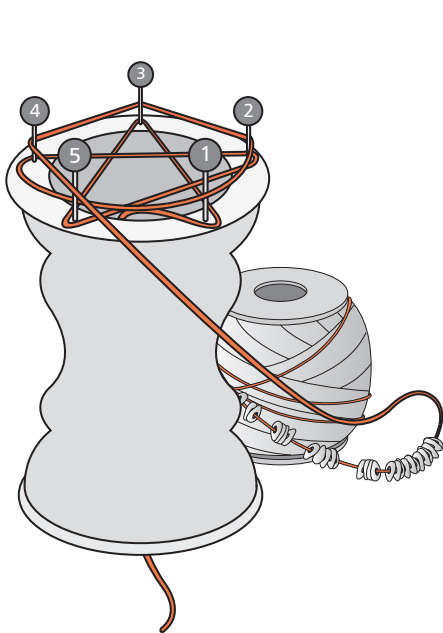
**Step 1:** To begin, you need 1 foot of string per inch of finished product desired. If possible knit straight off the spool. String all the beads onto the string.



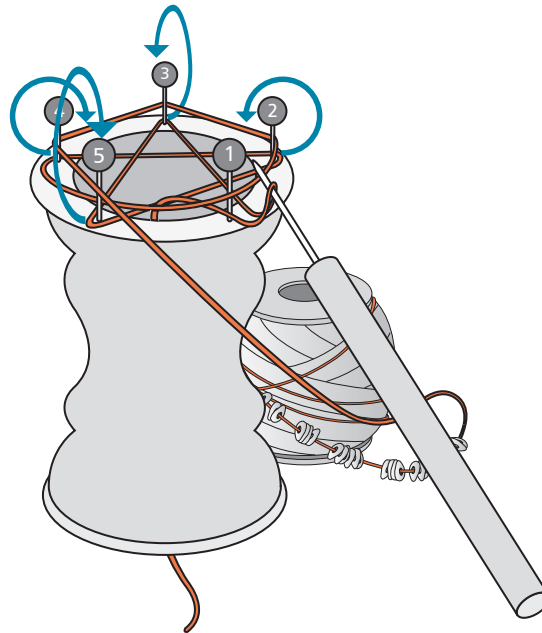
**Step 2:** Drop the tail of the string down the well of the spool.



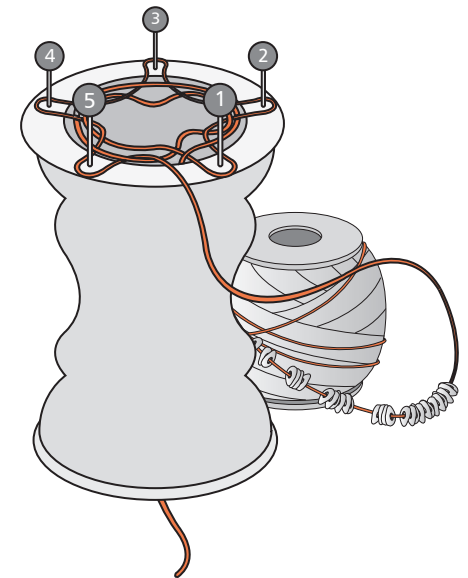
**Step 3:** Starting at #1 make a five-point star and stop when you return to #1.



**Step 4:** Wrap the string counterclockwise around the outside of the pegs starting at #1 and ending at #5.



**Step 5:** Beginning at #1, hook the bottom piece of string and lift up and over the top string and peg. Continue to do the same to all the pegs counterclockwise.



**Step 6:** Your knit work should begin to look like this. Repeat steps 4 and 5 three times before you begin to add beads. See phase 2 for adding beads and casting off.
