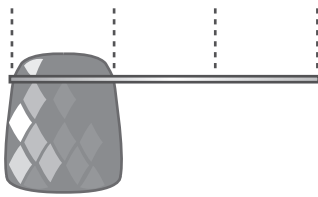
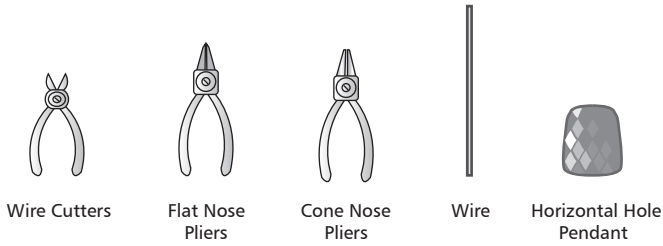
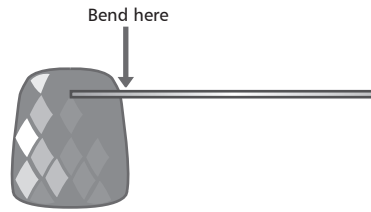


hanging pendants with horizontal holes

You will need the following supplies:



Step 1: With your wire cutters, cut off a piece of wire that is approximately 3 times the length of the hole in the pendant.



Step 2: Measure approximately half the length of the hole...



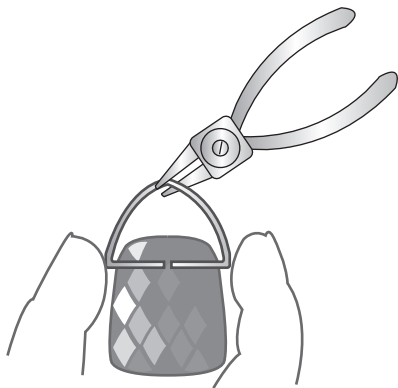
Step 3: ...and with your flat nose pliers, bend a 90-degree angled foot on both ends of your wire.



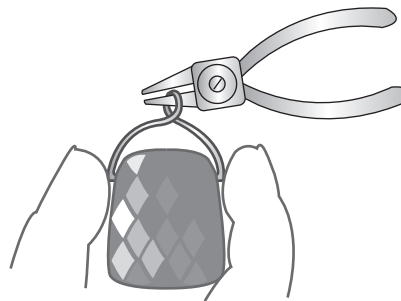
Step 4: With your hands, bend wire into a "D" shape so that the two ends meet.



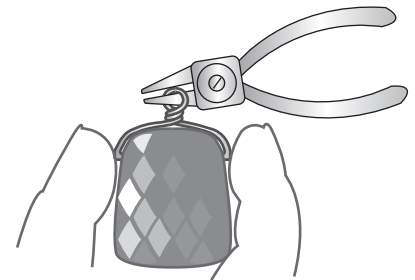
Step 5: Feed the ends into the holes of the pendant.



Step 6: Hold the sides of the wire firmly in the holes while you use your cone nose pliers to yank the wire upward to find the center of the wire.



Step 7: Continue to hold in the sides of the wire and begin to twist the cone nose pliers to form a loop in the center of your wire.



Step 8: Continue to twist the loop until the space between the wire and the pendant is minimal. String pendant on any chain, cord, or wire you desire.
